- 2. Jesus puts our possessions in perspective v.23-25
- 3. Jesus boldly proclaims that the path of salvation is only possible with God v.26-27
- 4. Jesus reassures that there will be NO regrets v.28-30
- 5. Jesus' disciples marvel at His completed mission v.31-34

## Jesus' death, burial and resurrection displays the wisdom & power of God – v.32-34 See Mark 8:31-33; 9:30-32

"...therefore I have set my face like a flint..." (Isaiah 50:7) ref. Leviticus 16 – *outside the camp* 

## Jesus rightly aligns our ambitions - v.35-41

Drink the same cup (see Mark 14:36)
Baptized with the same baptism (see Mark 15:34)
ref. Hebrews 13:12-13

## Jesus embodies and exemplifies sacrificial service – v.42-45

"But it shall not be so among you." (v.43) ref. 1 Corinthians 6:20
