The **EQUALITY** and **UNITY** of
the THREE PERSONS
as seen in O.T. passages:

Isaiah 48:16-17

Isaiah 61:1-2

God is one God – Deut. 6:4

New Testament Teaching

The **Father** is called God (1 Cor. 8:6)

The **Son** is called God (Heb. 1:8-10)

The **Holy Spirit** is
called God (Acts 5:3-4)

Combining these 4 statements affirms the Trinity

10 passages mentioning all 3 Persons

At the Believer's **SALVATION** – Heb. 9:14

At the Believer's **BAPTISM** – Matt. 28:19

In the Believer's **PRAYER LIFE** – Eph. 2:18

In the Believer's **GROWTH** – Jn. 14:26 / 15:26

In the Believer's **WITNESS** – Acts 1:7-8

In the Believer's **ASSURANCE** – 2 Cor. 13:14

In the Believer's **GIFTS** – 1 Cor. 12:4-6

In the Believer's **UNITY** – Eph. 4:3-6

In the Believer's **SINGING** – Eph. 5:18-20

In the Believer's **UNDERSTANDING** – Jn. 16:13-15

Regarding:

God the FATHER

Matthew 6:5-15 / 7:7-11 / 26:36-44

Luke 11:1-13 / Luke 5:16 / Lk. 9:28

Jn. 15:16 / 16:23-27 / Chapter 17

Regarding:

God the SON

John 14:13-14 / 15:16 / 16:23-34

Romans 8:31-34 / 1 Jn. 2:1 / Heb. 7:25

Matthew 27:50-51

Regarding:

God the HOLY SPIRIT

Romans 8:21-27

Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now. And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body. For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it. Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

He prays “for me” with a ***CONNECTION***
which I don't possess!

So...in what ways does the
HOLY SPIRIT of God speak to the Father on our behalf ?

He prays “for me” with a
the EXACT WORDS
that I cannot express!

*May our prayers display the
theology of the Scriptures....
the theology of the
TRIUNE GOD...may we pray, NOT
as unitarianists, but as
TRINITARIANISTS
addressed to the **FATHER**
in the name of the **SON**
“carried” by the **HOLY SPIRIT***
