I. WHO SHALL BE GOD? WHO WILL BE IN CONTROL OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD?

- A. God has ordained <u>leadership</u>, its qualities and <u>order</u> in the cosmos
- B. He has an <u>order</u> for how the cosmos is to operate. Two leadership groups operating two systems as one:
 - 1. The <u>heavenly</u> order for all the functions of heaven (elohim); includes the divine council
 - 2. The <u>earth</u> order of male and female teams, families, tribes, nations to sustain the earth's processes and systems (adam/adamah)
- C. <u>Righteousness</u> and <u>peace</u> exist when the two systems function in harmony with each other in a unified interdependent, interconnected, interrelated symbiotic relationship
- D. Any disruption in that order not sourced in God is <u>transgression</u>, perversion, iniquity, rebellion

II. FIVE GREAT TRANSGRESSIONS IN THE KINGDOM OF GOD: LAW TO CHRIST

A. The rebellion of the <u>cherub</u>, Lucifer, in heaven: to be <u>like</u> the Most High Isa 14:12-21; Eze 28:11-19

- B. The rebellion on earth by <u>people</u>, inspired by <u>Lucifer</u>: to be an <u>Elohim</u>Gen 3 Banished from the temple
- C. The rebellion on earth by <u>heavenly</u> beings for <u>control</u> of the <u>earth</u> Ha shem "the name" Gen 6:1-4; Flood; imprisonment of the rebels in Tartarus; nephilim
- D. The rebellion of men against God and the elohim for control of the earth: the <u>Tower</u> of <u>Babel</u>;
 Ha shem Gen 11:1-9 Division of the nations by language confusion with accountability to the sons of God the <u>divine council</u>
- E. The rebellion of <u>divine council</u> members to willingly become the "gods" of the Gentiles and assist them in rebellion against God for control of the kingdom Psalm 82; Romans 1

APPLICATION:

- 1) Repent and trust Jesus, the Christ. He is Lord of heaven and earth
- 2) Having trusted that Jesus is the Christ, Lord of all , set as the priority of your life the Kingdom of God and its righteousness
