






Christ restores our **vertical** relationship with God...

Christ restores our vertical relationship with God and our horizontal relationship with one another.




He tore down the wall.

Herod's "Second" Temple on the Temple Mount

King Herod the Great began renovations on the Second Temple approximately 20-19 BC. The entire temple expansion, including the massive Temple Mount, was not completed until approximately 62-64 AD, only to be destroyed by the Romans in 70 AD.




No foreigner is to enter within the forecourt and the balustrade around the sanctuary. Whoever is caught will have himself to blamed for his subsequent **death.**
