WCF Ch. 12. Of Adoption. 1. All those that are justified, God vouchsafeth, in and for His only Son Jesus Christ, to make partakers of the grace of adoption, by which they are taken into the number, and enjoy the liberties and privileges of the children of God, have His name put upon them, receive the spirit of adoption, have access to the throne of grace with boldness, (Eph. 3:12, Rom. 5:2) are enabled to cry, Abba, Father, are pitied, protected, provided for, and chastened by Him as by a Father: yet never cast off, but sealed to the day of redemption; and inherit the promises, as heirs of everlasting salvation. **WLC Q. 145.** What are the sins forbidden in the ninth commandment? A. The sins forbidden in the ninth commandment are...flattering, vain-glorious boasting, thinking or speaking too highly or too meanly of ourselves or others... **WLC Q. 46.** What was the estate of Christ's humiliation? A. The estate of Christ's humiliation was that low condition, wherein he, for our sakes, emptying himself of his glory, took upon him the form of a servant, in his conception and birth, life, death, and after his death, until his resurrection.
