 - a) Deity is explicitly attributed to Him and claimed by Him (John 1:1, 18, 5:18, 10:30, 20:28; Romans 9:5, 1 Tim. 3:16, Titus 2:13, Heb. 1:8, 10, 2 Pet. 1:1, 1 John 5:20).
 - b) The attributes of God are possessed and manifested by Him.
