## **Blessings of the Kingdom**

- 1. The Gracious OFFER of Blessing
- 2. The Surprising **FORMULA** of Blessing
  - a. It comes through **DESPERATION** not accomplishment.

    "Blessed are those who are poor for theirs is the kingdom of God" (v. 20b)

    "Woe to you who are rich, for you have received your consolation" (v. 24)
  - b. It comes through **LONGING** not satisfaction.
    - "Blessed are you who are hungry now, for you shall be satisfied" (v. 21a)
      "Woe to you who are full now, for you shall be hungry" (v. 25a)
  - c. It comes through **SORROW** not levity.
    - "Blessed are you who weep now, for you shall laugh" (v. 21b)
      - "Woe to you laugh now, for you shall mourn and weep" (v. 25b)
  - d. It comes through **REJECTION** not popularity.
    - "Blessed are you when people hate you and when they exclude you and revile you and spurn your name as evil, on account of the Son of Man" (v. 22)
      - "Woe to you, when all people speak well of you..." (v. 26)
