10 Hear, O LORD, and have mercy upon me: LORD, be thou my helper.

11 Thou hast turned for me my mourning into dancing: thou hast put off my sackcloth, and girded me with gladness: - *spirituality*

12 To the end that my glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever. - *Eternity in mind (focus on Lord)*

PSALM 31.

To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. *Rom 5:5 Rom 10:11*

IN thee, O LORD, do I put my trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in thy righteousness.

2 Bow down thine ear to me; deliver me speedily: be thou my strong rock, for an house of defence to save me. *11:2 incline thine ear*

3 For thou art my rock and my fortress; therefore for thy name's sake lead me, and guide me.

4 Pull me out of the net that they have laid privily for me; for thou art my strength. *25:15 mine eyes*

5 Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O *LORD God of truth.*

6 I have hated them that regard lying vanities: but I trust in the *LORD. Idol makers 26:5*

7 I will be glad and rejoice in thy mercy: for thou hast considered my trouble; thou hast known my soul in adversities;

8 And hast not shut me up into the hand of the enemy: thou hast set my feet in a large room.

9 Have mercy upon me, O LORD, for I am in trouble: mine eye is consumed with grief, yea, my soul and my belly.

10 For my life is spent with grief, and my years with sighing: my strength faileth because of mine iniquity, and my bones are consumed.

11 I was a reproach among all mine enemies, but especially among my neighbours, and a fear to mine acquaintance: they that did see me without fled from me.

12 I am forgotten as a dead man out of mind: I am like a broken vessel. *(like on cross)*

13 For I have heard the slander of many: fear was on every side: while they took counsel together against me, they devised to take away my life. *Unity of wickedness*

14 But I trusted in thee, O LORD: I said, Thou art my God.

PSALMS.

15 My times are in thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me.

16 Make thy face to shine upon thy servant: save me for thy mercies' sake. *vss 3 for thy names sake*

17 Let me not be ashamed, O *LORD; for I have called upon thee: let the wicked be ashamed, and let them be silent in the grave.*

18 Let the lying lips be put to silence; which speak grievous things proudly and contemptuously against the righteous.

19 Oh how great is thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that *fear thee; which thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!* *Faith*

20 Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the pride of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues.

21 Blessed be the *LORD: for he hath shewed me his marvellous kindness in a strong city.*

22 For I said in my *haste*, I am cut off from before thine eyes: nevertheless thou hearest the voice of my supplications when I cried unto thee.

23 O love the *LORD, all ye his saints: for the *LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.**

24 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the *LORD.*

PSALM 32.

A Psalm of David, *Maschil.*

BLESSED is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.

*2 Blessed is the man unto whom the *LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.**

3 When I kept silence, my bones waxed old through my roaring all the day long.

4 For day and night thy hand was heavy upon me: my moisture is turned into the drought of summer. Selah.

5 I acknowledged my *sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid.* I said, *I will confess my transgressions unto the *LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin.**
