### Four Millennial Views

#### • The Millennium

"Also I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is the first resurrection... When the thousand years are ended, Satan will be released from his prison and will come out to deceive the nations that are at the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them for battle" (Rev 20:4-5, 7-8).

- The Relationship between the Millennium and Christ's Return
  - *Historic Pre-Millennialism*: The Return of Christ is *before* the Millennium. Historic, because this is the pre-millennial view found in early church.
  - *Dispensational Pre-Millennialism*: The Return of Christ is *before* the Millennium. Dispensational, because it teaches that God has different purposes for different peoples (Jews, Gentiles, Church) and dispensations.
  - *Amillennialism*: There is no literal 1000-year reign; the millennium is the church age followed by the return of Christ. Amillennial, because it does not believe in a literal thousand years: the millennium is the gospel age.
  - *Post-Millennialism*: Christ will return after the millennium, when the Church has triumphed in the world. Millennium is not a literal thousand years, but a period of special triumph at the end of history.






*Historic Premillennialism*: The Church = True Israel *Dispensational Premillennialism*: The Church \not Israel


 The Second Coming *Historic Premillennialism*: One return of Christ *Dispensational Premillennialism*: Two-stage return w/ secret rapture
