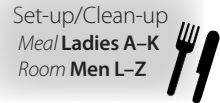

The Free Church traces its historical roots back to the Protestant Reformation in Scotland, which began in 1560. Our doctrinal standards are the original 17th century version of the *Westminster Confession of Faith* and *Larger and Shorter Catechisms*.
