

Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree")

Deuteronomy 21:22-23

22 "If a man has committed a sin deserving of death, and he is put to death, and you hang him on a tree, 23 his body shall not remain overnight on the tree, but you shall surely bury him that day, so that you do not defile the land which the Lord your God is giving you *as* an inheritance; for he who is hanged is accursed of God.

Joshua 10:26

"And afterward Joshua struck them and killed them, and hanged them on five trees; and they were hanging on the trees until evening."

2 Samuel 18:9

Now Absalom happened to meet the servants of David. For Absalom was riding on *his* mule, and the mule went under the thick branches of a great oak. And his head caught fast in the oak, so he was left hanging between heaven and earth, while the mule that was under him kept going.

<u>2 Samuel 21:9</u>

"and he delivered them into the hands of the Gibeonites, and they hanged them on the hill before the Lord. So they fell, *all* seven together, and were put to death in the days of harvest, in the first *days*, in the beginning of barley harvest."
