- 1. Read Jeremiah 6:10. In what sort of situations do you find others (or even yourself) resistant and even scornful to the gracious warnings of Scripture, as well as to those who relay them?
- 2. Read John 3:19-20. How can your sympathy for the unpleasant initial effect of the gospel tempt you to be unfaithful in presenting it clearly and completely? What aspects of the message are most commonly distorted?
- 3. Read 2 Chronicles 30:8-9. Why does a true representation of God and the gospel require an understanding of both God's judgment and compassion?
- 4. Read Colossians 1:12-14. How can the eternal and profound benefits of the gospel motivate you to fully articulate its unpleasant components?
- 5. Read Luke 15:11-24. Consider your own response to the gospel. How did the painful realization and confession of your sin serve to magnify the astonishing quality of the Father's forgiveness?
