


**“THE FIRST FOUR TRUMPETS
OF THE SEVENTH SEAL”**

REVELATION 8:6-13; SUPPORT SCRIPTURE

- I. EIGHT HOLY ANGELS SETUP THE EARTH FOR THE JUDGMENT OF EARTH'S REJECTION OF GOD**
- A. *Seven angels who stand before the throne; nearest to God; observe for God; report to God; act for God; each one given a trumpet*
 - B. *Another angel of the same kind sends the preliminary warning of the presence of God on earth - judgment in behalf of His people and His earth*
 - 1. *He is holding a golden censer for a particular duty to be performed. He is not acting independently of God; he is given much incense and the prayers of the saints*
 - 2. *With it still smoking and ascending to God, he takes more fire and sends the censer to the earth with no exact location given*
 - 3. *A colossal electrical storm follows, striking even more fear into an already fearful world*
 - 4. *When God spoke with Israel at their “wedding” Exodus 19:1-20. The world is warned to stay alert: God is present!*
 - C. *The seven angels are given 7 trumpets to herald the judgments of God to answer the abuse done to planet earth and to the heavens; Gen 1:26-28; 3:17-19; Lev 25; Deu 4:15-19; Acts 17:24-30; Rom 1:18-23*



II. FIRST TRUMPET - LAND JUDGMENT

- A. Action follows the trumpet but is not created by the trumpet; after the firestorm of the censer
- B. Hail, fire, mingled with blood thrown to earth
- C. 1/3 of earth burned; 1/3 of trees; all green grass
- D. That is the equivalent of North America and South America being burned

III. SECOND TRUMPET - SEA JUDGMENT

- A. Something like a great burning mountain is thrown into the sea
- B. 1/3 of the sea becomes blood; 1/3 of the living creatures die; 1/3 of the ships are destroyed
- C. That is the equivalent of the waters of the Pacific Ocean and the Mediterranean Sea being blood


IV. THIRD TRUMPET - FRESH WATER JUDGMENT

- A. A great star, named Wormwood, falls from heaven on 1/3 of the fresh water rivers/springs of the world
- B. 1/3 of the waters are poisoned becoming wormwood (bitter)
- C. Many die from drinking the water

V. FOURTH TRUMPET - UNIVERSE JUDGMENT

- A. 1/3 of the sun is struck; 1/3 of the moon and 1/3 of the stars struck and are darkened
- B. The brightness of the day is reduced by 1/3; the darkness of the night increased by 1/3
- C. Earth's temperature drops; breathing is harder


