Sermon: 14:1-6

1. Jesus says that He is the only way to the Father. A. What are some other ways that people claim that they can get to heaven? List at least 4.

B. How would you respond to a person who professed each of the views listed above?

2. How would you respond to someone who says, "Christianity thinks that they are the only religion that make it to heaven, how arrogant is that."

3. How could acknowledging God's sovereignty in the midst of suffering, trials, troubles, be a comfort to a Christian?

4. In John 14:1-6, what commands did Jesus give to his disciples? (Hint, 1 negative, 1 positive.)

5. How the two commands be of help to you when facing times of uncertainty? How do both the negative command and the positive command help?

6. When the Tabernacle was constructed, the Holy of Holies/dwelling place of God was off limits to everyone, except the High Priest. He was only allowed in once per year, and even then, only after he had performed all of the cleansing and sacrificing that God commanded (Lev. 16). Can you think of some ways that the Tabernacle, priest, sacrifice, and procedures pointed to Christ? See Hebrews 10:1-22 for help.
