SERMON OUTLINE

In Luke 10:25-37 we are taught how eternal life is to be lived in this life through an interaction between a lawyer and Jesus driven by 4 questions.

- I. A question intended to test (v. 25).
- II. A question intended to reveal (vs.26-28).
- III. A question intended to self-justify (v.29).
- IV. A question intended to convict (vs. 30-37).

BIBLE DISCUSSION GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS

In preparation for Sunday, March 25, 2018

Memory Passage: 1 Peter 3:13-17 (continue memorizing these verses you began last week)

DAY 1 - ASK FOR INSIGHT

(a) There are many approaches one can use to teach the good news of Christ (the Gospel) to someone who is in darkness. You could lead someone to Christ from any one book of the Bible, or from a specific section of Scripture (e.g. Acts 15, Romans 3, or Ephesians 1 & 2), or use an outline covering Biblical theology such as: (1) Creation, Fall, Redemption, Consummation, or (2) God, Man, Christ, Response. For our purposes this week we will prepare to teach the Gospel through asking and answering 4 important questions: Who is God? Who is man and what is man's problem? What is God's solution? How should I respond? We could examine many more passages of Scripture to support each point, but these few will suffice for our study this week.

(b) **Read Gen. 1:1, 27, Ps. 95:6-7, Is. 6:1-3, Dan. 4:34-35, Rom. 1:18, Col. 1:16-17, 1 John 4:16, Rev. 4:8**. As you read, formulate an answer to the question "Who is God?"

DAY 2 - ASK FOR INSIGHT

(a) **Read Gen. 1:26-28, 3:1-24, Rom. 1:18-32, 3:9-20, 6:23, 8:5-8, Eph. 2:1-3**. As you read, formulate an answer to the question "Who is man and what is man's problem?"

DAY 3 - ASK FOR INSIGHT

(a) **Read John 3:3, 16, Rom 5:5-8, 1 Cor. 15:1-4, 2 Cor. 5:21, Eph. 2:4-10, Col. 1:21-23** As you read, formulate an answer to the question "What is God's solution?"

DAY 4 - ASK FOR INSIGHT

(a) **Read Ps. 95:6-9, Mark 1:14-15, John 5:24, Acts 2:38, 16:30-31, Rom. 10:9-10**. As you read, formulate an answer to the question "How should I respond?"

DAY 5 - ASK FOR INSIGHT

(a) **Read 2 Cor. 5:16-21**. What other questions or truths, including Scripture passages to support them, would you add to what you have studied this week in order to better convey the truth of the gospel?

(b) As an ambassador for Christ, given the ministry of reconciliation, summarize in one paragraph the gospel presentation you have developed this week.
