## What is the purpose of history?

 According to the Scriptures, the purpose of history is to glorify God in the salvation of the elect and the judgment of the unbelie vers - all according to God's eternal plan.

#### The Covenant of Redemption

 In covenant theology, the eternal plan of God t o redeem the elect has been termed "the covena nt of redemption." It is the plan of God, among the Persons of the Trinity, each agreeing to the ir role in the work of redemption as each carries i t out. The Covenant of Redemption -Preliminary Cautions

- . Avoid tritheism
- . Avoid subordinationism (esp. of Son)
- Avoid mutability of God (e.g. the Son "comes t o agree" with the Father and Spirit).

The Covenant of Redemption -Foundations

- The Trinity is the foundation of the Covenant of Redemption
- Father, Son, and Spirit work out redemption in history according to an eternal plan; and that et ernal plan reflects the personal distinctions and relations of the Trinity.

### The Covenant of Redemption -Its Terms

- The Father appoints the Son to redeem, and p romises all power to accomplish this (see |saiah 42:1-7; John 5:31-36; 17:4-12).
- The Father gives a people to the Son to redee m (John 10:14-18, 27-30).
- To accomplish this, the Son comes as a man an d dies (Gal 4:4-5; Hebrews 10:5-10)

### The Covenant of Redemption -Its Terms

- The Son would receive exaltation (Philippians 2:9-11; Psalm 16:8-11 with Acts 2:25-28); and authority (Matthew 28:18; John 5:19-23).
- Father and Son will send the Holy Spirit to ap ply the finished work of the Son (John 14:26; 1 6:7-14; Acts 2:33).

The Covenant of Redemption -Its Uses / Applications

- Salvation is a precisely laid out, eternal plan of the Triun e God.
- To fully understand salvation, you must consider what ea ch person of the Trinity does to save you. (e.g. TULIP
- There is no imperfect or incomplete work of salvation. W hat one member of the Trinity starts, the others complet
  e. There is no intra-trinitarian disunity.
