"Give and Given"

A. "Give"

- 1. God as the Consummate Giver
- 2. Giving for us does not come naturally. Learned behavior.
- 3. Followers of Christ are to be givers. Psalm 37:21; Prov. 21:26
- Six Principles for Giving—2 Corinthians 9:6-11 4.
 - a. Private—"let each one give"
 - b. Planned—"as he purposes in his heart"
 - c. Proportional
 - 1) As to Income—2 Corinthians 8:11
 - 2) As to Need—2 Cor. 8:13-15

 - d. Painless "not grudgingly"
 e. Pressure Less "not of necessity"
 f. Pleasurable "cheerful giver"

B. "Given"

- 1. God gives GENEROUSLY—"good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom"
 - a. Ancient Illustration—measuring corn
 - Modern Illustration—scooping ice cream b.
 - c. Scriptural Illustrations
 - d. How God repays?
 - 1) Not necessarily in KIND
 - 2) Not necessarily in TIME
- 2. God gives PROPORTIONALLY—"with the measure that you use it will be measured back to you."
