Only Trust Him
Acts 2:22-36

Believing in God's:

I. Sovereignty - "counsel...foreknowledge of God" (vs. 22-24)

Not a God of Chance

Jesus provides through:

- A. Supernatural-"approved of God"
- B. Situation-"being delivered by...God"
- C. Sinners "by wicked hands have crucified and slain"

II. Scriptures - "Therefore being a prophet" (vs. 25-31)

Not a God of Confusion

Jesus provides:

- A. Help "He is on my right hand"
- **B.** Hope "my flesh shall rest in hope"
- C. Hero "raise up Christ to sit on his throne"

III. Salvation - "that same Jesus... Lord and Christ" (vs. 32-36)

Not a God of Condemnation

Jesus provides as:

- A. Martyr "that same Jesus, whom ye crucified"
- **B.** Master "God hath made...Jesus...Lord"
- C. Messiah "God hath made...Jesus...Christ"

Sentence Sermon:

"Trusting God's Word will lead us to place our trust in Jesus."
