## Model Employees!

### A. Slavery in Peter's day

- 1. Prevalence: 2/3 of the population were slaves
- 2. Old Testament and Slavery
  - a. Permitted and regulated
    - 1) Not to be abused Exodus 21:26-27
    - 2) Liberal severance package—Deut. 15:13-14
    - 3) Released on Year of Jubilee—Lev. 25:10
  - b. Not permitted: Kidnapping into slavery—Exodus 21:16
- 3. Differences between slaves in biblical times and slavery in America
- 4. Many saw slavery as a way of getting ahead in life
- 5. Differences between "slaves" and employees today

### B. Submission to Employers—1 Peter 2:18; Ephesians 6:5-8

- 1. General Principle: Submission regardless
  - a. Of treatment
  - b. Of religion. Working for a Christian boss—1 Timothy 6:1-2
- 2. Specific Manner of Submission
  - a. *"with all fear"*—1 Peter 2:18
    - 1) Extends to bosses who are "good" and "gentle"
    - 2) Extends also to bosses who are *"harsh"*
  - b. *"with sincerity of heart"* Ephesians 6:5; 1 Thess. 4:10-12
  - c. *"not with eye-service as men-pleasers"* Ephesians 6:6
    - 1) We are servants of God—1 Cor. 6:19-20
    - 2) All work is sacred—Colossians 3:23
    - 3) We work for ONE BOSS—Jesus Christ
  - d. "with good will doing service"

### C. Submission to a Nasty Boss—1 Peter 2:18-20

- 1. Problem: Slaves and "nasty" masters
- Principle: Submission when treated unfairly pleases God!
  a. No praise for wrong-doers 1 Peter 2:20
  - b. Blessing for those who do good and yet suffer. Matt. 5:11-12

### **D.** Submission TODAY

- 1. We should seek to be the BEST employees we can be.
- 2. When treated harshly, we do have options available.
- 3. Whatever option we choose, we need to maintain our Christian witness! Titus 2:9-10
