Biblical illiteracy, 9.9a

- From “Hosanna” to “Crucify” - What went wrong?
- Knowing the bible
- Cherry-picking versus all the word of God
 - 1900 years before Jesus, Genesis 49.10ff
 - 1400 years before Jesus, Numbers 24.17, 19
 - 900 years before Jesus, I Kings 1.38-40
 - 700 years before Jesus, Isaiah 62.11, 63.1-3
 - 500 years before Jesus, Jeremiah 23.5
 - 400 years before Jesus, Zechariah 9.9-10

Absolute truth. 9.9b

- Kings have authority
- Today’s struggle with authority
- Righteousness: implies a standard
- People need saved
- An absolute claim

Choices have Consequences, 9.9

- Whatever is best for me...
- Proverbs 14.12
- Jesus models choosing
- Our choices

Lack of Vision, 9.10

- Jesus’ agenda for the universe
- Getting on board
- Already/not yet
- Our hope
