

2 – Made Alive together with Christ

Col. 2:13 And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, <u>God made alive together with him</u>, having forgiven us all our trespasses,

Eph. 2:1 And <u>you were dead</u> in the trespasses and sins **2** in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience— **3** among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. **4** <u>But God</u>, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, **5** even when we were dead in our trespasses, <u>made us alive together with Christ</u>—by grace you have been saved— **6** and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, **7** so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

John 14:16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, 17 even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you. 18 "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. 19 Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. 20 In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you.

2Pet. 1:3 <u>His divine power</u> has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence, **4** by which he has granted to us his precious and very great promises, so that through them you may <u>become partakers of the divine nature</u>, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world because of sinful desire.

Consider: Jesus is Always with Us

3 – Union to Christ by the Holy Spirit

Rom. 8:9 You, however, are not in the flesh but <u>in the Spirit</u>, if in fact <u>the Spirit of God dwells in you</u>. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. **10** But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, <u>the Spirit is life</u> because of righteousness. **11** If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead <u>dwells in you</u>, <u>he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also</u> give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.

His Life by the Spirit (VS 10)

Cleansed by the Spirit

Titus 3:4 But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared, **5** he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit, **6** whom he poured out on us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, **7** so that being justified by his grace we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Spirit Power (VS 11)

"If the Spirit of HIM WHO RAISED Jesus from the dead dwells in you"

Holy Spirit as Guarantee of Our Salvation

2Cor. 1:21 And it is God who establishes us with you in Christ, and has anointed us, **22** and who has also <u>put his seal on us and given us his Spirit</u> in our hearts as a guarantee.

2Cor. 5:4 For while we are still in this tent, we groan, being burdened—not that we would be unclothed, but that we would be further clothed, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life. **5** He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the Spirit as a guarantee.

Eph. 1:13 In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were <u>sealed</u> with the promised <u>Holy Spirit</u>, **14** who is the guarantee of our <u>inheritance</u> until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

Eph. 4:30 And do not grieve the <u>Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed</u> for the day of redemption.

4 - Union with Christ as "Living in the Spirit"

Rom. 8:5 For those who <u>live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh</u>, but those who <u>live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit.</u> **6** For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but <u>to set the mind</u> on the Spirit is life and peace.

Flesh Spirit **Gal. 5:22** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, **23** gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

Gal. 5:16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. **Gal. 5:17** For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do.

Gal. 5:25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit.

1Cor. 2:14 The <u>natural person</u> does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are <u>spiritually discerned</u>. **15** The <u>spiritual person</u> judges all things, but is himself to be judged by no one. **16** "For who has understood the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?" <u>But we have the mind of Christ</u>.

Eph. 4:1 I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, **2** with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, **3** eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. **4** There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— **5** one Lord, one faith, one baptism, **6** one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.
