Jesus Died According to the Scriptures

Luke 23:44-56 Pastor Phil Winfield March 29, 2015

For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. 1 Cor 15:3-5

Let's look briefly at THE DAY THAT JESUS DIED.

- 1. The **<u>lights went out</u>** the day that Jesus died (v.44-45)
 - a. The darkness indicates **Judgment**.
 - b. The darkness indicated that **<u>sin</u>** was being judged.
 - c. The darkness indicated that there was an **interruption** in Divine Fellowship.
 - d. The Darkness indicated the end of the **Old Covenant**.
- 2. **<u>Redemption</u>** was accomplished the day that Jesus died (v.46)
 - a. Jesus did not leave any task undone Jn 19:30
 - b. Jesus did not **expire**; He breathed his last! Jn 10:17 -18
- 3. Hard hearts were **<u>softened</u>** the day Jesus Died (47-49).
 - a. The **<u>Centurion's</u>** heart was softened.
 - b. The hearts of the **<u>crowds</u>** were softened.
- 4. Fearful people found <u>courage</u> on the day Jesus died (50-54).
 - a. **Joseph** became bold when Jesus died.
 - b. **Nicodemus** became courageous when Jesus died(John 19:39-42)
 - c. The <u>**Women**</u> were bold when Jesus died.
