

# Psalm 91

## The Best Hiding Place

### Outline

### Overview

Pay close attention to the **pronouns** in this psalm. They tell us who is speaking and to whom.

Verse 1 is written in the \_\_\_\_\_ person: “**He** who dwells . . . .”

Verse 2 is in the \_\_\_\_\_ person. The psalmist says, “**I** will say of the LORD, ‘*He is my* refuge and **my** fortress; **my** God, in Him **I** will trust.’”

Verses 3-13 are \_\_\_\_\_ person, addressed to the reader: “Surely He [that is, God] shall deliver **you** . . . .”

Verses 14-16 are \_\_\_\_\_ person, but this time God is speaking: “Because he [the righteous one] has set his love upon **Me**, therefore **I** will deliver him. . . .”
