- B. A WASHING INFINITELY MORE IMPORTANT** (Heb.9:10f /Lk.12:4f; Rm.6:23; Rv7:14 / Ps51:2; Is.1:16f)
- C. THE ABSOLUTE SUPERIORITY OF CHRIST DECLARED** (1:1-3; see Jn.1:1-14; Col.1:19; 2:9)

**II. OUR EAGER EXPECTATION OF SALVATION** (9:28b)

- A. THOSE EAGERLY AWAIT HIM** (28; see Is.8:17; 1Cor.1:7; Gal.5:5; Phil.3:20; Tt.2:13; Rom.8:19f; Rev.22:20)
- B. PREVIOUS CONTEXT** (9:1-22)
  - 1. change: *reconciliation* w/God through **sacrifice** for *redemption* (1-14; see 7f, Lv.16 /Eph.1:7; Col.1:14; 1Pt3:18)
  - 2. continuation: *covenant* with God through **sacrifice** for *inauguration* (15-22; see 8:10d; Hos.1:10)
  - 3. conclusion: **sacrifice** is necessary for all of this (22; blood = judicial death; see Rom.6:23; 2Cor.5:21)

**III. ONCE: SALVATION ACCOMPLISHED** (9:23-28)

- A. REAL & REFLECTION** (23,24; 11; see 8:2,5; 10:1; Col.2:17; see 2Cor.4:16f; heaven/earth; invisible/visible)
- B. CLEANSE HEAVENLY THINGS** (23; see 18f, (inauguration, dedication); see 12:22f)
- C. BETTER SACRIFICES: HIMSELF** (23,26,28/25b; see 12,14; 10:5f; 13:12)
- D. SINGULAR SACRIFICE** (25,26,28; see 12; 7:27; 10:2,10f; contrast 25b, 7f; 10:1f /Lev.16:21; Day of Atonement)
- E. ONCE FOR MANY** (28; see Mt.26:28; Rom.5:12f; Jn.1:12; see Lev.16:21)
- F. ABSURD: IF OFTEN, THEN ALWAYS** (25,26a; but see 15a)
- G. ONCE MARKS THE CONSUMMATION OF THE AGES** (26b, 10:18; Jn.19:30; see Heb.1:2; Acts 2:17; see Mk.13:4f,28f & 24f,32f)
- H. HIS PERSONAL PRESENCE** (26b-28)
  - 1. once: **FOR FORGIVENESS** of sins *He has been manifested* (26c,28a; 12,14; see Jn.12:27; 1Jn.3:8; Lk.4:18)
  - 2. second: [apart from (forgiveness of sins)] *He will be seen* **FOR SALVATION** (28b /2Th.2:8f; Rev.19:11f; 20:9)
- I. ILLUSTRATION & APPLICATION** (27,28)
  - 1. illustration: men die *once then* judgment (27; see 2Cor.5:10)
  - 2. application: Christ died *once then* salvation (28a)
  - 3. consequence: eagerly wait (28b; see Is.8:17; 1Cor.1:7; Gal.5:5; Phil.3:20; Tt.2:13; Rom.8:19f; Rev.22:20)

**IV. WASH YOUR SOUL & EAGERLY WAIT!**

- A. BEWARE OF THE BLASPHEMY OF THE REPEATED SACRIFICE OF CHRIST!** (6:6; see 9:25,26,28; see 12; 7:27; 10:2,10f,18; contrast 25b, 7f; 10:1f; see Lev.16:21; Day of Atonement)
- B. UNDERSTAND ONE SACRIFICE, ONE OFFERING, MANY APPLICATIONS!** (9:12,14,22,26,28; see Lev.16:15f; see slaughter, sprinkle, incense // crucifixion, ascension; intercession; 9:26, 9:14; 9:24 (7:27,25))
- C. WASH YOUR SOUL!** (9:10,13,14,22f; 10:2; Eph.1:7; Col.1:14; see Jn.13:5; 1Jn.1:9; Is.1:16f; see Heb.9:13,19; Num.19:9f; 31:23; Ezk.16:4; 36:25; Eph.5:26)
