Sermon:	Sincere Christian Love Among Christians
Scripture:	Philippians 3:17-4:3 (text 4:1-3)

Introduction: I John 3:17-18

- I. Love for one another's highest good, greatest need; a Christian's greatest concern for another Christian is his perseverance in the faith (4:1).
- II. Love among us as Christians, being on good terms with each other, working side by side in harmony for Christ and His kingdom; a Christian's priority in his relationships and between other Christians who aren't reconciled with each other (4:1-2; Heb. 13:1; Romans 12:10; I Peter 1:22; John 13:33-34; 17:23; Col. 3:12-14; Phil. 2:1-3)
- III. Love's involvement in reconciliation between others; a Christian's self-denying initiation of and continuing assistance to Christians who are not reconciled to one another (4:3; Matt. 5:9; Romans 12:18)
