 - E. Falsely accused by Potipher's wife. (Genesis 39:6-9)
 - F. Imprisoned. (Genesis 39:21-23)
 - G. Forgotten by the cup-bearer. (Genesis 40:8-16, 23)
 - H. Brought before pharaoh. (Genesis 41:16, 39-40)
 - I. Reunited with his brothers. (Genesis 50:18; 45:4-5)
