MARK 1:34-39

Mark 1:35-39 (ESV)

- 35 And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, He departed and went out to a desolate place, and there He prayed.
- **36** And Simon and those who were with Him searched for Him,
- **37** and they found Him and said to Him, "Everyone is looking for You."

- 38 And He said to them, "Let us go on to the next towns, that I may preach there also, for that is why I came out."

I. Jesus Found a Desolate Place to Pray (v. 35)

35 And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, He departed and went out to a desolate place, and there He prayed.

Acts 8:1 (ESV)

1 And Saul approved of his execution. And there arose on that day a great persecution against the church in Jerusalem, and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles.

Acts 8:4-5 (ESV)

- 4 Now those who were scattered went about **preaching** (**euangelizo**) the word.
- 5 Philip went down to the city of Samaria and proclaimed (kerysso) to them the Christ.

- 42 And when it was day, He departed and went into a desolate place. And the people sought Him and came to Him, and would have kept Him from leaving them,
