Scripture Reading: Luke 24:13-35

- A. Easter wasn't day of joy for all!
 - 1. Do you struggle with others about the *mystery of Easter*? (Luke 24:11)
 - 2. Do you struggle like others with troubling doubts? (Luke 24:37)
 - 3. Do you struggle like others with unbelief out of joy? (Luke 24:41)
- B. With all these cases, the Lord dealt similarly in two ways,
 - 1. Preached Himself from OT pages (vs. 27, 44)
 - 2. Enlightened their understanding which made their heart burn (vs. 32, 45)

THE RISEN SAVIOR'S MINISTRY

- I. SEEKING OUT HIS DISTRESSED SHEEP II. CORRECTING HIS ERRING SHEEP
 III. FEEDING HIS HUNGRY SHEEP
- I. The risen Saviors ministry in seeking out His distressed sheep
- A. Good/Best News: God is at work in saving lost sinners
 - 1. One-sided grace is the only door of hope for lost and undone world
 - 2. It is also for them in whom He has begun His good work (Phil. 1:6)
- B. How does God seek out His distressed sheep?
 - 1. He draws us by inviting us to reveal our burdens, question, needs (15)
 - a. their answer reveals a lot we possibly can identify with (18-24)
 - they were puzzled about the Gospel (vs. 19-21)
 - they were distressed about the way things went (21)
 - they were caught in grip of unbelief (vs. 21-24)
- II. THE RISEN SAVIOR'S MINISTRY IN CORRECTING HIS ERRING SHEEP
- A. Jesus hammers home a solid rebuke (vs. 25)
 - 1. Unbelief is a grievous sin
 - a. even though in these men it was an infirmity of unbelief
 - b. certainly after having been told so often out of His own mouth

- B. Jesus begins to correct their thinking through preaching OT truths: vs. 26-27
 - 1. Good preaching is *expounding the Word*
 - a. it is bringing forth the glories of Christ so that hungry souls are directed to look away from their own poor self to Him!
- C. What did Jesus need to correct in their thinking?
 - 1. that the Messiah would go through the cross to the crown (26)
 - a. redemption wasn't just a temporal or physical or emotional thing
 - b. redemption is a *spiritual rescue of crushing and condemning burden* of guilt in God's court (Luke 4:18-23)

III. THE RISEN SAVIOR'S MINISTRY IN FEEDING HIS HUNGRY SHEEP

- A. For at least two hours, Jesus preached from OT Scriptures about Himself
 - 1. Impossible to know what He all covered but it has one theme (vs. 26)
- B. In these two hours, Spirit of God is also at work: vs. 32
 - 1. Work of Spirit *enlightening revealing opening mind to Christ's glory* a. His work is mostly *the still small voice*
 - b. His saving work will make the heart to burn within for Christ
 - 2. Has God done that to your heart already?
 - a. if so, what will be your prayer?
 - 3. Note that it didn't take much effort to constrain Jesus to stay (vs. 29)
