<i>Stanza</i>	<i>Verses</i>	<i>Summary</i>
1.	1–8	Lord, <u>stabilize me</u> in obeying your word.
2.	9–16	Lord, use your word to <u>protect me</u> from ruining my life.
3.	17–24	Lord, <u>teach me</u> your word.
4.	25–32	Lord, I'm weary; <u>strengthen me</u> with your word.
5.	33–40	Lord, <u>make me</u> love your word all my life & with all my heart.
6.	41–48	Lord, <u>fulfill for me</u> all the promises you've made.
7.	49–56	Lord, in my affliction your words <u>comfort me</u> .
8.	57–64	Lord, <u>enable me</u> to remain committed to your word.

9.	65–72	Lord, keep using trials to <u>mature me</u> in obeying your word.
10.	73–80	Lord, <u>encourage me</u> with the love promised in your word.
11.	81–88	Lord, how long till you <u>help me</u> ?!
12.	89–96	Lord, you're sovereign; I'm yours; <u>save me</u> as you promised.
13.	97–104	Lord, I love your word; with it you <u>give me wisdom</u> .
14.	105–112	Lord, your words <u>guide me</u> through my dark trials.
15.	113–120	Lord, <u>sustain me</u> in loving your word.
16.	121–128	Lord, I love your word; <u>rescue me</u> now!

<i>17.</i>	<i>129–136</i>	Lord, graciously <u>ble</u> ss me as you've promised.
<i>18.</i>	<i>137–144</i>	Lord, you <u>del</u> ight me with your righteousness.
<i>19.</i>	<i>145–152</i>	Lord, I cry for the help you promise in your word; <u>hear me!</u>
<i>20.</i>	<i>153–160</i>	Lord, <u>rest</u> ore me as you've promised.
<i>21.</i>	<i>161–168</i>	Lord, trials still abound, but you <u>calm me</u> with your word.
<i>22.</i>	<i>169–176</i>	Lord, <u>pres</u> erve me till I praise you for fulfilling your promises.

Psalm 119 in Summary

Lord, I love your word. Keep me faithful to your word as I wait on you to fulfill every promise in it.

2. In prayer, beg for God to help you obey his word.
3. In prayer, wait on God to fulfill the promises of his word.
