looking forward to the blessed hope and appearance of the glory of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ:...

who gave Himself on our behalf in order that He might redeem us from all lawlessness, and might cleanse for Himself a special people, zealous<sup>1</sup> for good works. [DJP]

*lutron* = price paid to loose or free

*lutrousthai* [λυτροῦσθαι] = to free by paying the *lutron* (Titus 2:14; 1 Pet. 1:18)
