**TWO GENERATIONS**

**Judges 2:6-10**

**I. Doctrine: *Two (Contiguous) Generations Can Be As***

\_\_\_\_\_ **as *Night and Day***  
A. –This may be Because Only *one* has any Vital

\_\_\_\_\_ of The Lord . . . , (Judg. 2:7)

B. . . . And/Or Because the \_\_\_\_\_ was Not Faithfully *Passed On* (or *Received*), (Judg. 2:10)

**II. The Transitional \_\_\_\_\_ that Characterized the *Two Generations*, vv. 6-10**

A. –The *First* Generation *Somewhat* \_\_\_\_\_ The Lord (being graced with good leaders), vv. 6-7

B. –Joshua's Death \_\_\_\_\_ *Both a Challenge and a Fulfillment* (of Promise), vv. 8-9

C. –The *Next* Generation was \_\_\_\_\_ (and largely Faithless), v. 10

**III. How the Church Today is to \_\_\_\_\_ the Issues of *Two Generations***

A. –We are Not to \_\_\_\_\_ our Predecessors (for all of our Problems) . . . , (Judg. 2:8)

B. . . . Instead, we are to Take our \_\_\_\_\_ Covenant Privileges and Responsibilities *Seriously*, (Judg. 2:10)

**Key Verse—v. 10: “When all that generation had been gathered to their fathers, another generation arose after them who did not know the LORD nor the work which He had done for Israel.”**
