Winston Smith says, "Trichotomy is the belief that human beings consist of three basic components: body, soul, and spirit. While the operations of these three components appear seamless, they are nonetheless distinct and have discrete properties. Each component, therefore, is considered responsible for overlapping but largely separate operations within human beings: the body for the physical, the soul for the psychological, and the spirit for the spiritual (defined as vertical dimension, relationship with God)."
