1. Overview of Passage & context. Remained our background.

2. Love: The great testimony of the church - 1 JOHN 4:12
3. Love: A great remedy within the church - 1 PETER 4:8
 - a. Stephen, "Lord do not hold these things against them."
 - b. Woman at the Well, "I who speak to you am he."
 - c. Adulterous woman, "Neither do I condemn you, go and sin no more."
4. We come to 1 CORINTHIANS 13:13
 - a. Now - during this whole present age in contrast to the apostolic age.
 - b. Abide - Present tense - continuous abiding - continuous remaining.
 - c. Faith remains - ROMANS 10:9.
 - d. Hope remains - ACTS 24:14-15
 - e. Love remains - GALATIANS 5:22
 - f. These three - A trinity of characteristics of the Christian life.
5. The greater of this trinity is love
 - a. The fruit of faith will be realized in heaven.
 - b. The hope of the resurrection will be realized in heaven.
 - c. However, love abide on into eternity - 1 JOHN 4:8
 - d. As Verses 1-3 show the preeminence of love, so too Verse 13.
6. Review the passage with the understanding that the perfect or verse 10 is the perfect Word of God.
