## "The Offense of the Cross" Galatians 5:7-12

We are at all times to live in accord with the gospel and to glory in its clear proclamation!

1. Living in accord with the Gospel of the Cross

vv. 7-10

(1) Vigilance is necessary at all times!

"You were running well.

- One can start well, but must continue!

Who hindered you from obeying the truth?

This persuasion is not from him who calls you."

- The enemy of our souls ever seeks to sow error and falsehood.

(2) The gospel is to be obeyed! "Who hindered you from obeying the truth (of the gospel)?"

- "Who hindered you?" "cut in on you"
- How is the gospel to be "obeyed?"
  - By obeying God's command to believe in Christ's work alone as sufficient to save.
  - By confessing that it is by faith alone that one is justified.
  - By living in accord with the gospel: *living* by faith in Christ alone.
  - By giving no place to those who preach a different gospel.
- (3) The gospel is to be guarded!
  - -1- No addition of works is to be tolerated! "A little leaven leavens the whole lump."
  - A proverb and its meaning:

A small part introduced that then permeates and dramatically affects the whole.

- Applied: This (teaching) alters the whole understanding of salvation and of the Christian life.

-2- Adherence to Apostolic doctrine is vital!

"I have confidence in the Lord

- Close adherence is a feature of true faith.

that you will take no other view than mine, and the one who is troubling you will bear the penalty, whoever he is."

- cf. 1 Jn. 4:6

- Rejection of Apostolic doctrine calls for discipline.
  - Such rejection is revelatory of the state of the heart! cf. 1 Jn. 2:19

## 2. Preaching the Gospel of the Cross

vv. 11-12

(1) Brings persecution!

"But if I, brothers, still preach circumcision, why am I still being persecuted? In that case the offense of the cross has been removed."

That he preached and taught favorably of circumcision. But if that were the case he wouldn't be facing constant persecution (by the Jews)!

- "Offense" - "stumbling block" Gk: SCANDALON

- Apparently a slander circulated conc. Paul

## - The offense of the cross:

The cross rejects all human merit and glory and teaches that salvation comes only from the crucified Savior. cf. 1 Cor. 1:23

(2) Requires 'calling out' the enemies of the cross!

"I wish those who unsettle you would emasculate themselves!"

- A malediction!

- Sacral castration was practiced in some pagan religions and cults!
- i.e., "Since these false teachers mutilate the gospel, let them mutilate themselves!"
