- 4. What did the jailer choose to do before the quake and what does this say about who he was?
- 5. What did Paul and Silas choose to do with their freedom?
- 6. What emotions must have overcome the jailer that would have caused him to prepare to kill himself?
- 7. What did Paul and Silas instill in him (4 letter word beginning in "H") in verse 28?

- 8. What do the jailer's posture, actions and question indicate about his disposition in verses 29-30?
- 9. What must one do to be saved?
- 10. What does verse 32 add to the story?
- 11. What do the actions of the jailer in 33-34 indicate about him now?
- 12. Why did Paul not just end his imprisonment as quickly as possible when given the chance?
- 13. What do Silas and Paul's actions in verse 40 indicate about their overall mission?
- 14. Take some time quietly listen to the Lord in prayer. What would the Holy Spirit want you to know about your life situation and how He would have you live in light of the reality of what God has done and is doing in Christ?
