Mark 6.1-6a / The Poisonous Effects of Unbelief

Theme: Outright unbelief acts as poison introduced into the pure water of Jesus' ministry

1. Jesus returns to Nazareth with His disciples
2. His teaching in the synagogue causes a great stir
3. His presence and teaching bring out the worst in the populace
4. Given their deathly reaction to Him, His freedom to exercise His power was limited

Ezekiel 33.1-9 The Watchman and the Sword

Heidelberg Catechism Q/A 115

Theme: The watchman announces the deadly danger of violations of the commandments

1. Preachers as watchman are to announce commandment violations
2. God wants His commandments preached this way to warn His people
3. You are warned of these violations of the first table of the law: respond
4. You are warned of these violations of the second table of the law: respond
