#### TWO MINISTERIAL METAPHORS - I Cor 3:5-15

**INTRODUCTION**: 1C 3:5-15.

## Introduction: The Minister's Identity - v5

- 1. *Servants* deacons: <u>4:1-2</u>. the minister's ministry, not personality.
- 2. *Each one* [servant] is *given by Lord* magnifies grace of Giver 3:21-23.
- 3. Minister defines self, not in relation to other ministers, but to the Lord.
- 4. Result? *thru whom you believed* the church's believing & belief. How?

### 1st: The Agricultural Metaphor - v6-9

- 1. Paul then Apollos plant & water: minister Word of God. Pastoral farmers
- 2. Both are servants neither is *anythg* Cor's boasting -> celebrity. Humility
- 3. Both must *labor* "copious": cast seed promiscuously & water abundantly labor copiously -> exhaustion
- 4. Each receives his own reward according to his labor. Reward labor, not Cor "success." Be faithful. Fruit is up to God. Well done faithful servant.
- 5. God causes growth [2x v6-7]. We are G's fellow workers God is at work in & thru pastor's labors [Isa 55:11]. Word accomplishes God's purposes.

# 2nd: The Architectural Metaphor - v9-15

- 1. Church: God's field & God's building. Farmers & construction workers.
- 2. Foundation: *Jesus*, laid by apostle [v10]. Pastors build w/ *care* [v10 watchful attentiveness]. Foundation: 1C 2:2 gospel. *Edify* build up.
- 3. Building material? Same quality as foundation. People [living stones 1Ptr 2:5] and/or doctrine. *Gold, silver, precious stones* not *wood, hay, straw*
- 4. These analogies re: material describe each man's work [2x inclusio of v13; v14, v15 = 4x in v13-15]. Entire pastoral labor is in view.

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- 5. Reward is promised for faithful work [v14] when? Fire of Final Judgment: reveal the quality of man's work remains or is burned up [Jms 3:1].
  - i. Do not build w/ combustible material quality. Xn pastor will be saved. The issue is rewards.
  - ii. The metaphors motivate us to be careful to give X quality work.
- 6. **Encouraged:** we are unworthy servants [Lk 17:10] our persons & performance is *grace*. Our confidence is not in our service, but our Savior.
- 7. **Encouraged:** we labor not in vain [1C15:58].
- 8. **Exhorted:** Be diligent, careful, faithful & be expectant eternal rewards!
