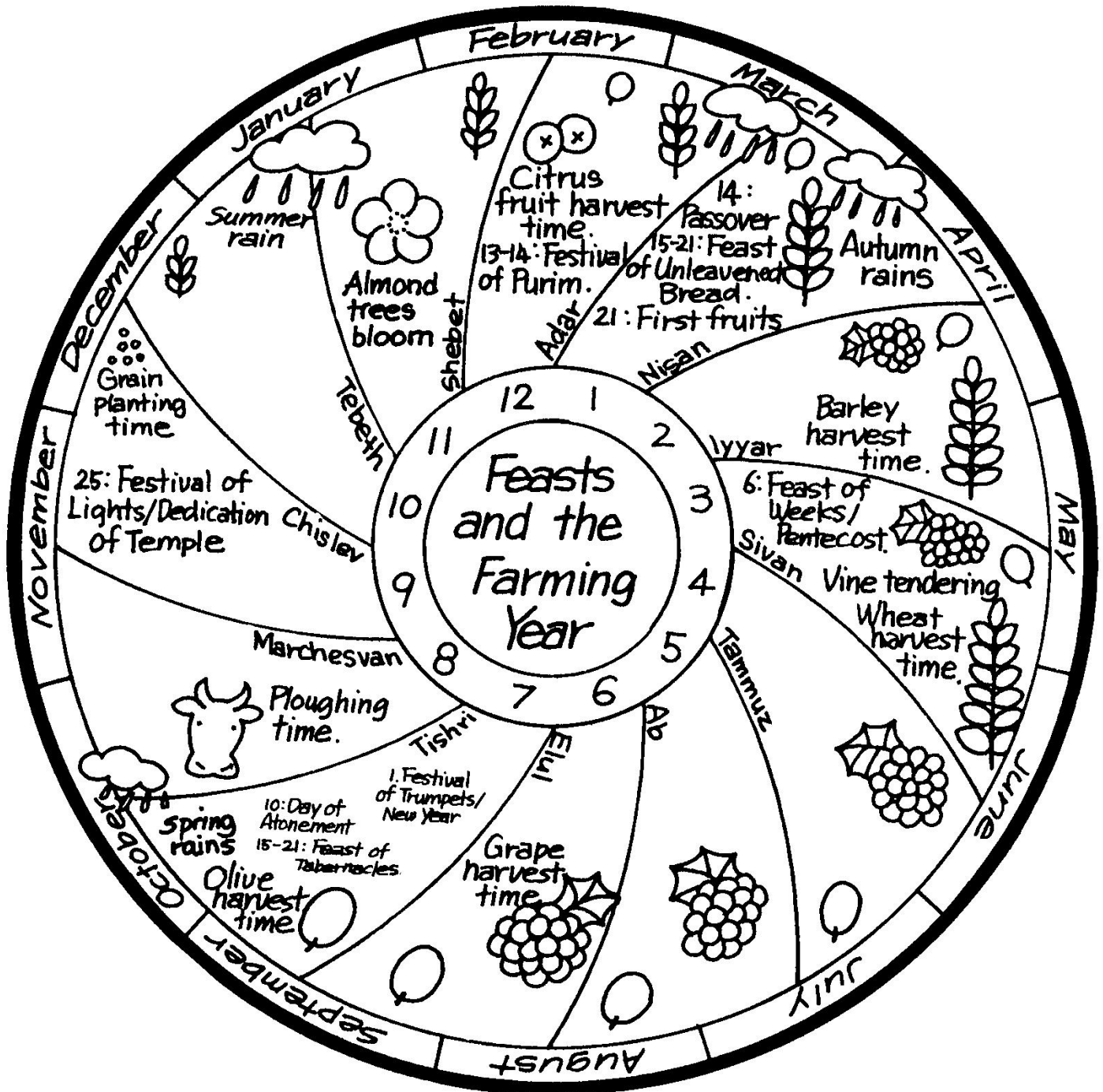


# The Feasts of the Lord

# The Feasts (Appointed Times) of the Lord

## JESUS

### WEEKLY

#### 1. **The Sabbath**

The seventh day of every week  
A day of solemn rest.

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Matthew 12:18

### SPRING

#### 2. **The Passover**

The 14<sup>th</sup> day of the first month  
It is holy day commemorating God's deliverance  
of Israel from bondage to Egypt.

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1 Corinthians 5:7

#### 3. **The Feast of Unleavened Bread**

The 15<sup>th</sup> day of the first month and lasting for 7 days  
A week of meal offerings to the Lord.

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Hebrews 4:15

#### 4. **The Feast of Firstfruits**

The 22<sup>nd</sup> day of the first month  
Thanking God for the first fruits expresses faith in God  
to continue to bless the whole season to the last of the harvest.

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1 Corinthians 15:20-23

#### 5. **The Feast of Weeks (Pentacost)**

The 50<sup>th</sup> day from the last Sabbath of Passover.  
Celebration of a great harvest.

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John 16:7

### FALL

#### 6. **The Feast of Trumpets**

The 1<sup>st</sup> day of the seventh month  
It is generally referred to as a time  
of repentance and regathering.

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1 Corinthians 15:52

#### 7. **The Day of Atonement**

The 10th day of the seventh month  
A day of corporate repentance.

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Revelation 1:7

#### 8. **The Feast of Booths**

The 15<sup>th</sup> day of the seventh month and lasting for 7 days  
it was a memorial in the booths to  
the wandering of Israel for forty years.
