## **Application Questions**

- 1. Read **Exodus 20:17**. From your own experience describe the feeling of "coveting" in your own words. How would you assume to explain God's rationale for pairing the sinful response of coveting to dissatisfaction with material things *and* one's marriage relationship?
- 2. Read **Colossians 3:5**. Do your best to explain why you think the Bible would state that "covetousness" and "sexual immorality" are considered "earthly." Why does it make sense that "covetousness" is "idolatry"?
- 3. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:3-6. How would you respond to someone who says that because he is a Christian and

because all of his sins were "paid for on the cross" he receives nothing but "grace and blessing from God" no matter how big he sins?

4. Read **Hebrews 12:12-17**. What makes the biggest impression on you when you read this passage and why?

5. Read **1 Timothy 4:2-5**. What specifically will you do this week to follow the exhortation found in this passage?
