MISSIONARIES OF THE WEEK

Tony and Mickie West serve in the Hope Center in Haiti, where Tony is a Physician's Assistant. They moved to Haiti in 2011 to build a medical clinic with But God Ministries. The Hope Center has expanded dramatically during the past decade, adding an orphanage, church, dental clinic, and veterinary clinic, as well as facilitating construction of many houses for the local people.

The Wests had planned to return to Jackson in October, 2019, but by then BGM had evacuated its American staff because of political unrest and the presence of a very dangerous gang that was terrorizing people near their mission. The political unrest subsided after four months, but the dangerous gang with home base only two miles from the Hope Center was still alive and strong.

Mickie says that their Haitian staff has done a fantastic job of carrying on with the mission. Their schools have remained in session in spite of other schools throughout the country being closed. The Clinic was opened last winter under the direction of the Haitian leadership. The Children of Christ Home Orphanage remains safe and secure.

Tony and Mickie say that they are actually seeing a miracle take place through the leadership of the Haitian staff that God has raised up. While the Wests firmly believe that they will be able to return to Haiti, they are confident that God's will is being done there and that peace and restoration will take place.

While stateside, Tony has been working as a Nurse Practitioner in a local nursing home. He also continues to manage the finances of Hope Center and help the leadership carry out administrative tasks each week via WhatsApp. Tony says, "The situation is not ideal, but it has grown us all in many ways and it has helped our Haitian leadership realize their value and potential. This is huge."

First Presbyterian Church has supported the ministry of Tony and Mickie West since 2012.
