## I Thessalonians 2:13-3:13

MAIN IDEA: We should find joy in God's working in the lives of other believers.

    - \* How it was not received (2:13a)
    - \* How it was received (2:13b)
  - B. Their rejection by the world (2:14-16)
    - ❖ The experience of rejection (2:14; cp. 3:1-5; II Thess. 1:5-9)
    - The extent of rejection (2:15-16)
    - \* The explanation for rejection
- II. THERE WOULD BE JOY IN THE <u>FUTURE</u> BECAUSE OF THEIR PRESENCE IN HEAVEN (2:17-20).
  - A. Paul's possible joy in the future (2:17-18)
    - ❖ The object of this joy would be to see them again on earth (2:17).
    - \* This had been hindered (2:18).
  - B. Paul's promised joy in the future (2:19-20)
    - \* The object of this joy would be to see them in heaven (2:19).
    - \* This could not be hindered (2:20).
- III. THERE IS JOY IN THE <u>PRESENT</u> BECAUSE OF THEIR <u>PROGRESS</u> IN THE CHRISTIAN LIFE (3:1-13).
  - A. Joy produced from Timothy's visit (3:1-8)
    - ❖ Timothy was sent out of deep concern (3:1-5).
    - ❖ Timothy returned with great comfort (3:6-8).
  - B. Joy reflected in Paul's prayer (3:9-13)
    - \* The joy resulted in thanksgiving (3:9).
    - ❖ The prayer was directed toward greater growth (3:10-13).
- Have you experienced past joy when you trusted in Christ as Savior?
- Are you experiencing present joy as you and other believers grow spiritually?
- Will you experience future joy when you see the results of your ministry?
