- I. Personal determination to evangelize
 - Obligated (vs. 14)
 - Eager (vs.15)
 - Not ashamed (vs. 16)
- II. God-exalting reason to do so
 - lt's the power of God! (vs. 16)
- III. Universal necessity to believe
 - Faith is:
 - $_{\odot}$ to everyone who believes
 - what "marries" you to Christ (His assets are now yours)
 - o not a one-time act-it's a way of life

Application:

- 3) In what ways did Paul adapt to the culture around him?

- 6) If everything we do should be rooted in the Gospel, how will that affect our everyday choices and future decision-making processes?
