The Lord's Reassurance

Exodus 6:1-7:7

1. What stood out to you from the sermon?

2. In 6:1-5, the Lord reassures Moses that he is the same God and it is the same plan.
 - How can these truths be helpful to us when things seem to go from bad to worse?

 - Why is this sometimes hard to believe?

3. In 6:6-9, the Lord reassures the people with what he will do for them and how they can trust his hand.
 - How do God's promises toward us reassure us?

 - How can thinking about God's hand reassure us?

 - How does the peoples' response in vs 9 comfort and challenge us?

4. In 7:1-7, the Lord reassures Moses when he questions his role in the process.
 - How does the scope of God's plan help us when things don't seem to be going according to plan?

 - How can it encourage us when we feel like we are inadequate for what God has called us to do?
