- 1. Read **Psalm 113**. How is the detailed recognition of God's specific care for his people in this passage magnified and made even more praiseworthy when put against the backdrop of the statements in vv.4-6?
- 2. Read **Isaiah 66:1-2**. Why is our concern for obeying God's word diminished when we fail to maintain a "high view" of God? Why do you think a low view of God fosters pride and self-interest?
- 3. Read **Psalm 132:1-5** and **1 Kings 8:27-30**. Realizing that both David and Solomon understood that God could not be localized by a physical worship center in Jerusalem, why do you think they would be so intent on establishing this more permanent worship structure?
