Preaching to the Tares and Wheat Hebrews 5:11–14

Introduction: The necessity of preaching messages that balance the needs of the tares and wheat within every church.

Preach messages of rebuke, exhortation and warning to the tares.

Although, the true believer needs to here messages of rebuke and exhortation, in this particular case the writer of Hebrews is focusing on preaching a message of encouragement to the true child of God.

I. True Child of God, be encouraged, you are beloved by the leaders in the church.

II. True child of God be encouraged by your response to the revelation of God's goodness.

The content of their response to the revelation of God's goodness was better. Genuine believers have a better response to the enlightenment of God then the counterfeit believers.

Genuine believers have a better response to the heavenly gift then counterfeit believers.

Genuine believers have a better response to the work of the Holy Spirit then counterfeit believers.

Genuine believers have a better response to the word of God then the counterfeit believers.

Genuine believers have a better response to the powers of the age to come than counterfeit believers.

The consequence of their response to the revelation of the goodness of God was better.

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III. True child of God be encouraged, your motivation for ministry is grounded in his love for God.

The ministry that is grounded in the love of God is a continual ministry.

The ministry that is grounded in the love of God is others minded.

The ministry that is ground in the love of God is an act of righteousness.

IV. True Child of God be encouraged by your exemplary life. 1 Thessalonians 1; 2:13–14
