JOEY FAUST (4-10-22)

**TEXT: Mark 12:24** And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?

**26** And as touching the dead, that they rise: **have ye not read** in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him, **saying, I am** the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?

**27** He is not the God of the dead, but the God of the living: ye therefore do greatly err.
