## I. THE DIFFERENCE JESUS MAKES WHEN HE IS SAVINGLY ENCOUNTERED:

[Acts 5:8-14 / Acts 8:13-23 / 1 Cor. 5:5-13 / 1 Cor. 11:27-32]

Remember: Romans 1-3:20-- THE HUMAN RACE HAS A SIN PROBLEM:

This is why the world acts as they do! THE ONLY HOPE: Eph. 2:1-10

# II. JESUS MAKES A DIFFERENCE BECAUSE OF THE NATURE OF GOD'S SALVATION OF SINNERS

## 4. Romans 4:1-5 God justifies wicked, UNGODLY people who trust in him.

#### TRUE OR FALSE STATEMENT:

"It is in the Cross of Christ that we find the only means whereby a sinner is acquitted before Holy God!"

- 1. Before the judgment bar of God, NO ONE is acquitted...!
- 2. The whole human race is CONVICTED, GUILTY, and deserves only the just sentence of God's holy justice and wrath!

#### THAT'S WHAT ROMANS 1-3:20 IS ALL ABOUT!

God does NOT acquit the guilt— He REDEEMS the wicked…! ☐ Rom. 3:24-26

III. In Romans 3:21-28 there are four images of God's 'DIFFERENCE MAKING' salvation: Propitiation, Redemption, Justification, and Reconciliation.

Don't forget, "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Rom 3:23).

1. SIN IS - REBELLION; a willful rejection of God's Word and his standards.

- 2. SIN IS a FAILURE to show proper reverence to God through godly behavior.
- 3. SIN IS "MISSING the MARK" because we are not loving or obedient.
- 4. SIN IS TRANSGRESSION, crossing over or going beyond a limit that God has set.
- 5. SIN IS sin that results from IGNORANCE; this ignorance can be due to an unwillingness to be open to God's truth (Eph. 4:18)
- 6. SIN IS DISOBEDIENCE that results from inattention.

## What is Justification?

"Justification is a declaration that **the believing sinner**, (whose ADVOCATE is Jesus Christ), **is considered just in God's sight, due to** the merits of the precious blood of Jesus Christ!"

As another has said, "... in justification God does gracious GRACE arithmetic:"

## In redeeming sinners:

- 1. God SUBTRACTS from us our sin;
- 2. Then He ADDS to us, in sin's place, the righteousness of Christ. `

## **GOD** justifies the ungodly who believe on Him! (Rom 4:5)

How can God treat unrighteous people as being righteous?

# V. JESUS MAKES A DIFFERENCE BECAUSE OF the Source, Grounds, Means, and Effects of Justification

1. What is the source of justification? (Rom 3:24). (Rom 8:33)

(Rom 3:10).

God justifies by Christ's blood (Rom 5:9); (Rom 3:25); (Rom 3:24).

2. Paul tells us we are "justified by faith" (Rom 5:1; Rom 3:22).

And how gracious God is... in giving faith: Ephesians 2:8-10

The 'word pictures' of John 3:13-19, are rooted in Numbers 21:8,

TODAY THE LOST SINNER **who owns** his inbred poison of sin and **who looks** to Jesus for salvation— HE LIVES!

In order to be justified, we must receive what God, out of grace, has done for us by the blood of Christ. (John 1:10-13)

## 3. What are some of the DIFFERENCE MAKING Effects of Justification?

- A. When God justifies us, **God accepts us.** [] **Eph. 1:6**
- B. A second effect of justification is **holiness**, or sanctification.

**ROMANS 8** 

C. A third effect of justification is **CONFIDENCE** (Rom 8:33-34)
