

Darius I	522-486	Haggai and Zechariah prophesy (520) Zechariah prophesy (518) Temple completed (516) (Ezra 5-6)	Rebuilding of the Temple begins again

Zechariah 9:14-17 (ESV)

9:14	Then the LORD will appear over them, and his arrow will go forth like lightning; the Lord GOD will sound the trumpet and will march forth in the whirlwinds of the south.	9:16	On that day the LORD their God will save them, as the flock of his people; for like the jewels of a crown they shall shine on his land.
9:15	The LORD of hosts will protect them, and they shall devour, and tread down the sling stones, and they shall drink and roar as if drunk with wine, and be full like a bowl, drenched like the corners of the altar.	9:17	For how great is his goodness, and how great his beauty! Grain shall make the young men flourish, and new wine the young women.

arrow and the trumpet

- names and titles for God
 - LORD Yahweh
 - Lord GOD Adonai Yahweh
- Judah and Ephraim
 - o bow and arrow (v. 13)
- military language
 - o his arrow like lightning
 - o trumpet Lord GOD will sound
 - march forth
- whirlwinds of the south
 - o Sinai
 - Job 38 God answers Job out of a whirlwind
 - 2 Kings 2 Elijah taken to heaven by a whirlwind
 - Zechariah 7 exile like a whirlwind
 - whirlwinds in the desert south
- God as defender

 - Leviticus 4:7
 - sacrifice complete

 - young men and young women enough for all
- Easter text
 - "Christ has risen. He has risen indeed."
 - the resurrection/the new heavens and new earth
