- 4. What are the primary *doctrinal* points of this passage? Do you *believe* these things?
- 5. What are the primary *practical* points? Do you *do* these things?
- 6. What was the role in the resurrection of Jesus of each Person of the Trinity? (see section I)
- 7. What are the historical objections to the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead?
 - a. Why is each one *invalid*?
 - b. Why are *you* persuaded of the historical truth of the resurrection?
- 8. How does the resurrection prove Jesus a true prophet? What is the consequence of this truth?
- 9. What is the significance of the resurrection for Christ's sacrifice and priesthood?
 - a. How does this relate to the forgiveness of your sins?
 - b. How does this relate to your confidence in prayer?
- 10. What is the significance of the resurrection for Christ's kingship?
- 11. What is the significance of the resurrection for the old creation and the new creation?
- 12. Who will be raised at the last day, for what purpose and to what end?
- 13. How does the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead distinguish Christ among all the other gods and religions?
- 14. How important is faith (cognizance, conviction & commitment) in the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead?
- 15. What is the significance of baptism in view of the resurrection?
- 16. What is the significance of the Lord's Supper in view of the resurrection?
- 17. When do we celebrate the resurrection and why do we celebrate it then?
- 18. Where has God declared the truth and consequences of the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead? Therefore, what should we do? Do you do this?
- 19. How does the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead give you hope in every sorrow?*
