Descending from greatest number of verses to least:

1. Because Jesus was raised from the dead, others can be raised and healed.

Isaiah 26:19; (Ezekiel 36, 37); Matthew 27:52, 53; John 5:25; 11:24; Acts 4:10; Romans 8:11; 1 Corinthians 6:14; 2 Corinthians 4:14; Colossians 2:12; 1 Thessalonians 4:14, 16; 1 Peter 1:3

2. Resurrection puts an end to agony and decay, bringing instead spiritual life in a new body.

Job 19:25, 26; Psalm 16:10; 49:15; Matthew 22:30; Mark 12:25; John 20:19-21:19; Acts 2:24; 13:34, 37; Romans 6:5, 9; 1 Corinthians 15:42-44, 52; Philippians 3:10, 11

3. Resurrection results in testimony.

4. Jesus was raised so that we could experience resurrection life now.

5. Resurrection is the fulfillment of God's promises in the Old Testament.

6. Resurrection guarantees our justification.
